The Concordia Parish Attendance Recovery Program will take place at parish schools which house grades 6-12. The purpose of the attendance recovery program is to provide an opportunity for students to make up for excessive absences for the sake of attendance only. Only those students, who have their principal's permission and are in good standing with their schools, may participate in this program. The program will be held on nonschool days, primarily Saturdays. Students will make up two hours of program time for each class period that a student has missed, i.e., two class periods equals four hours of program time. Students are to work on productive academic tasks such as homework, reading a novel, working on a project, or completing test prep work provided by the program teacher. Students should bring academic work with them to this program. Students will not be allowed to sleep or sit unproductively. If a student becomes disruptive or fails to complete assigned work or comply with the rules, he/she will be dismissed from the program without any credit for time served and will be unable to participate in the program for the remainder of the school year. Students must wear school uniforms to participate in the program and must follow all school rules including the rules regarding the use/possession of cell phones.

Students will be responsible for their own transportation and lunch. The program will run from 8:00-2:00 on the designated days; therefore, students will have the opportunity to make up six hours for the entire day. Students must stay until at least 12 noon and will not be allowed to leave and re-enter.

The Attendance Recovery Teacher's decision to dismiss a student from the program because of a lack of effort or failure to comply with the rules is final.
